Please understand the puppies are not sold on a trial basis and all sales are final. Consider the care and commitment that it takes to have a dog. The average life span of a LABRADOODLE is 12-15 years. With lots of love, patience and commitment you will have a long time loyal companion. Puppy(s) is sold with NO BREEDING RIGHTS unless otherwise agreed upon in advance. Puppy(s) must be spayed/neutered by NINE (9) months of age and proof must be sent to the breeder. If not received health warranty becomes void and it will be assumed the dog is being used for breeding; the buyer shall pay the breeder the sum of \$5,000. FOR BREEDING RIGHTS. If, for any reason, a dispute arises about said puppy(s) any court action shall be taken up in the Duval County court in Florida.

Puppy(s) is guaranteed to be in good health, current on vaccinations/worming for age. Buyer has three (3) business days to have puppy(s) examined by their Veterinarian and if found to have a life threatening illness or disease whether genetic or congenital (does not cover improper bite or umbilical hernias also excludes parasites internal or external ie: fleas, ticks, coccidia, giardia or an easily treated illness; many of which can be brought on by the stress of a new environment) buyer has seven (7) days to return the puppy to the breeder with paperwork, including that from the Veterinarian, for a full refund of the price of the puppy only. Breeder reserves the right to have a second Veterinarian opinion before issuing a refund. TAKE CAUTION WHERE YOU TAKE YOUR PUPPY(S) UNTIL THE ENTIRE SERIES OF PUPPY SHOTS HAVE BEEN GIVEN (16-18 WEEKS OF AGE). In the best interest of the puppy(s) health avoid pet stores, dog parks, other animals until completely immunized. Puppy(s) health guarantee is to the original purchaser against debilitating life threatening hereditary and/or congenital diseases including hip dysplasia (severe), vWD (affected), hereditary debilitating cardiac issues and/or hereditary disabling eye disease until puppy reaches one (1) year of age. If any of the issues are found and supported by full documentation from certified Veterinarian the breeder will replace puppy(s) with a puppy(s) of equal value as soon as available. Breeder may have the puppy(s) examined by Veterinarian to verify diagnosis. It is also understood that breeder is not responsible for Veterinarian expenses or transportation. Guarantee is void if puppy(s) is transferred to a new home before one (1) year of age. If puppy(s) is found to be overweight, not fed a quality diet and/or involved in strenuous, repetitive exercise until puppy(s) at least one (1) year old this will void the health guarantee. Also not included are health issues that may be caused by environmental factors such as allergies, autoimmune disorders, trauma, abuse and/or failure to maintain the general health of the dog, . Buyer agrees that the puppy/dog will be housed indoors, fed a quality diet, kept current on vaccinations and heart worm preventative. If circumstances arise where buyer cannot keep the dog buyer agrees that the puppy/dog will never be taken to an animal shelter/rescue or any facility used for research and will make every effort to find a suitable home as long as puppy(s) has been spayed/neutered; OR MUST BE RETURNED TO THE BREEDER WITH NO REFUND. I have read and understand the terms/conditions and understand this is a binding agreement on buyer and breeder.
